Celebrant: ... be with you [all.] or: Grace to you...and the Lord Jesus Christ. Rx: And with your Spirit.


PENITENTIAL ACT

Celebrant: May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life. **Rx: Amen.**




COLLECT *People respond:* **Amen.**

Lector: The word of the Lord. **Rx:** Thanks be to God. *(concluding the reading)*




- 1. The Lord is my saving light; whom should I fear? And God is my fortress; what should I dread, what should I fear?






LORD'S PRAYER AND FINAL DOXOLOGY






