PENITENTIAL ACT


A: I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do,

or **C:** (invocations with Kyrie)

Celebrant: May almighty God have mercy on us, forgive us our sins, and bring us to everlasting life. Rx: Amen.


FIRST READING: Proverbs 8:22-31


The Communion Rite

Celebrant: Lord Jesus Christ, who said to your Apostles: Peace I leave you,


my peace I give you, look not on our sins, but on the faith of your Church, and graciously grant her peace and unity in accordance with your will.

People respond to the blessing(s): Amen.


DISMISSAL
